Thanks to our members, we will be making some minor changes in 2011. Your feedback, from the survey distributed with the

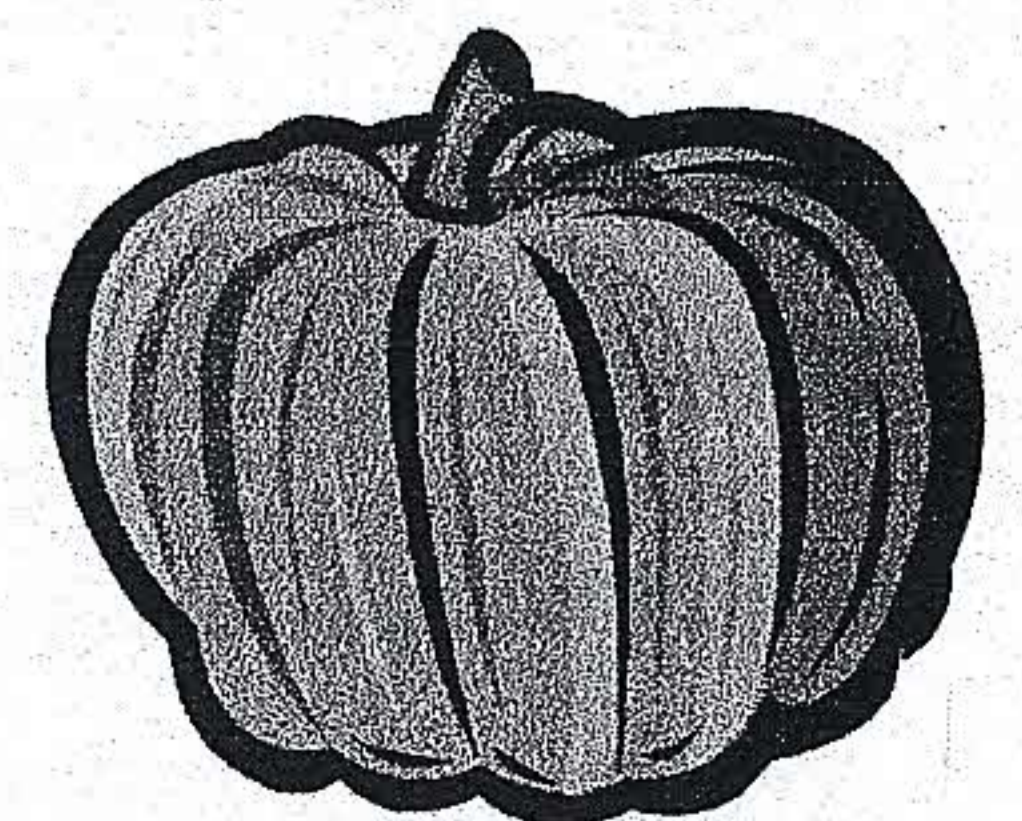
